- 6. Pancake Breakfast Raechel Bartel and John Johnson organized the pancake breakfast held during Catholic School's Week. There were some student complaints that it held in the cafeteria instead of the hallways and STEP rooms. This move was done for both safety and sanitary reasons. The PAC recommended that student government get more involved in this activity and the PAC offered to sponsor/cook the breakfast.
